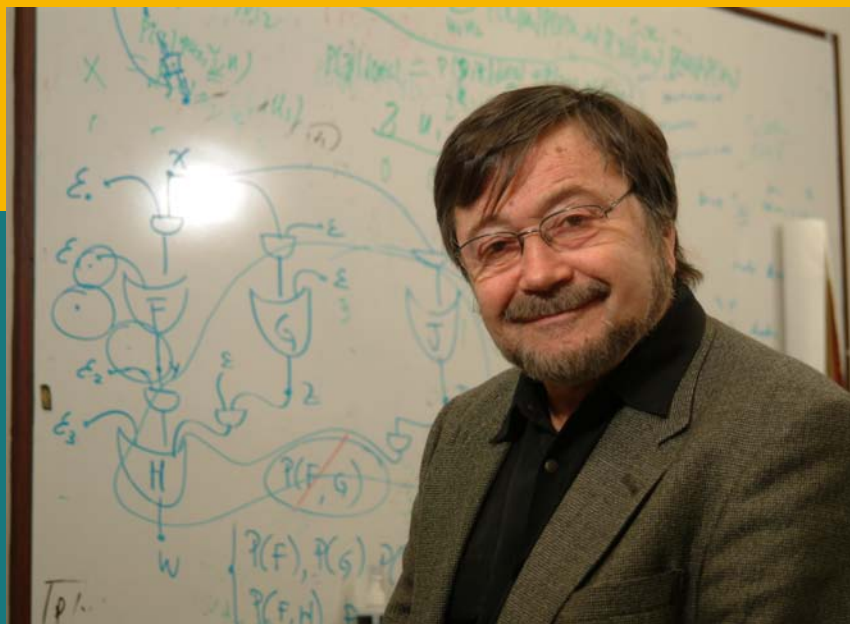


BEING AMERICAN AND JEWISH IN THE POST-9/11 ERA: THE LEGACY OF DANIEL PEARL

The Daniel Pearl Dialogue for Muslim-Jewish Understanding featuring Akbar Ahmed and Judea Pearl was devised by Professors Pearl and Ahmed out of a shared concern about the deterioration of relationships between the Muslim and the Jewish communities and a shared belief that reconciliation of these two Abrahamic faiths is critical and can only be achieved through the re-establishment of respectful dialogue. As Daniel Pearl saw open and honest dialogue as the key to mutual respect and understanding, so Akbar Ahmed and Judea Pearl hope their dialogue will help encourage mutual respect and understanding among all people of diverse background.
